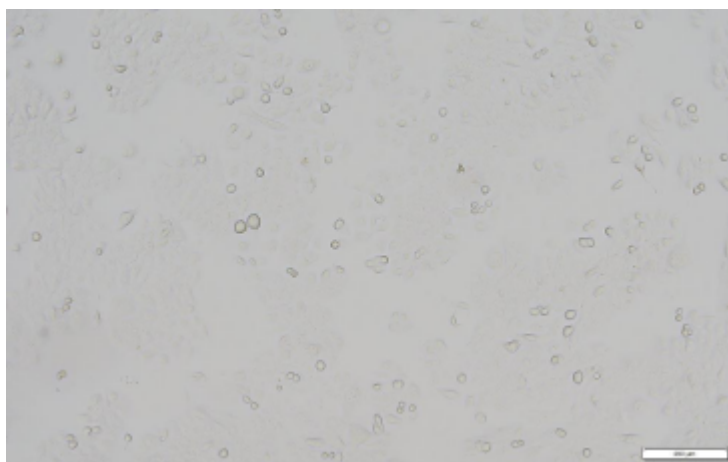
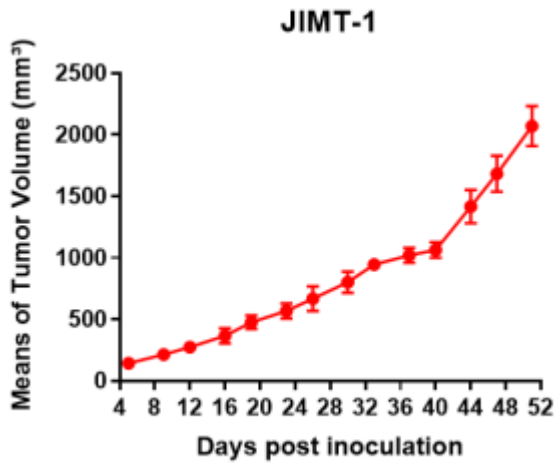
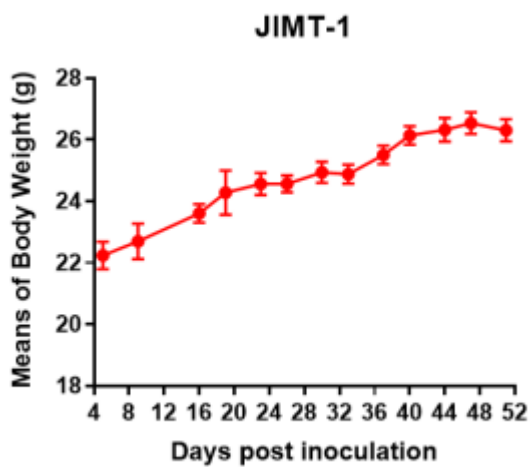


Fig1. Morphology of JIMT-1 cell line.
